Report of 7 October 2025

We were privileged to have a visit from District Governor Peter Behm.

The toast to Rotary international was proposed by Simon Trebilcock who mentioned the ongoing good work of Rotary over many years, including the world wide move to eradicate polio.



DG thanked Simon for the toast and the way in which it was received.

He congratulated Traralgon Rotary Club on achievements so far this year, noting our achievements to fit in with the District Governor's award. Under the leadership of Janne and Charlie Speirs, he could see that the future of the club is in safe hands. He noted the initiative to share leadership of meetings and widen the experience of various members.



He also congratulated those who have recently become members and joined the work of Rotary International to make a difference in the world through the many and varied projects we undertake.



Peter went on to mention matters important in all clubs including working to retain members once they have joined by making their experience in Rotary a positive one.



He reminded us of the importance of using approved branding in our work and advertising as this presented a united front to all who engage with Rotary.

DG Peter presented Janne with two certificates, one recognising that through club fundraising we make a donation to the Rotary Foundation on behalf of each member. We were also recognised for our generous donation to the Polio Plus fund.

DG Peter was thanked for his attendance and presented with a 'tree certificate'. The meeting concluded with a reminder to **Unite for Good**.



Board Meeting Notes

- As our square terminal is no longer being supported by square, it was resolved that a new square terminal be purchased for \$329
- The Mental Health Golf Day had a net surplus of \$30,093 , and it was resolved that \$15,000 be donated to Lifeline
- Funds of \$10,400 have been collected from Gippsland Rotary Clubs with a district grant which will be given to GRCH for the purchase of a ride on mower
- The Board resolved to assist Isobel McAlister to the amount of \$3,000 to enable her attend the Biology Summer School which will then select students to complete at the International Biology Olympiad in Lithuania in July 2026
- New Club Sign - Janne, Lorraine and Glenn A are looking at creating a new club sign at the entrance to Traralgon with the help of a District Grant
- Time Capsule - we have purchased two plaques for the 1975 and 2025 Time Capsule. However as the Rotary Symbol was not in the correct format , the Board resolved to order an additional Plaque at a cost \$1200
- St Pauls AGS will be holding a Wheely Day in November with the help of our club
